

ENVIRONMENTAL DECLARATION: COMPLIANCE WITH REACH, ROHS, AND SCIP REQUIREMENTS

SENECA S.r.l., headquartered in Via Austria, 26 – 35127 Padua (PD), Italy, hereby declares that the electronic products designed, assembled, and supplied to its customers comply with current legislation regarding health protection, operator safety, and environmental safeguarding, as set out by the following European regulations and directives:

REACH (REGULATION (EC) NO. 1907/2006 AND SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS)

In accordance with the REACH regulation, the products supplied by SENECA S.r.l. are classified as articles, pursuant to Article 3(3) of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006, and, under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use, do not release hazardous substances that may affect human health or the environment.

Based on current knowledge and the information provided by our suppliers of electronic components and materials, we confirm that none of the substances identified as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) and included in the Candidate List maintained by ECHA (European Chemicals Agency) are present in our products in concentrations above 0.1% w/w.

Should future updates to the list or changes in product composition require reassessment, we will promptly inform affected customers.

SCIP (SUBSTANCES OF CONCERN IN ARTICLES, AS SUCH OR IN COMPLEX OBJECTS – PRODUCTS)

In compliance with Article 9(1)(i) of Directive 2008/98/EC, as amended by Directive (EU) 2018/851, and implemented in Italy through Legislative Decree No. 116/2020, SENECA S.r.l. declares that its products are not subject to the obligation to notify the SCIP database managed by ECHA.

This exclusion is based on the absence of SVHC substances in concentrations greater than 0.1% w/w in the supplied articles, as defined by the REACH regulation. This evaluation is based on documented analysis and official declarations received from our supply chain.

ROHS (DIRECTIVE 2011/65/EU, DELEGATED DIRECTIVE 2015/863/EU, AND SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS)

SENECA S.r.l. products comply with Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS II) and the related Delegated Directive 2015/863/EU (RoHS III), concerning the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. Our products respect the maximum concentration values set out in Annex II of the directive, taking into account applicable exemptions listed in Annexes III and IV (e.g., lead in copper alloys).

Restricted substances and their maximum limits are as follows:

- Lead (Pb): < 1000 ppm
- Mercury (Hg): < 1000 ppm
- Cadmium (Cd): < 100 ppm
- Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI): < 1000 ppm
- Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB): < 1000 ppm
- Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE): < 1000 ppm
- DEHP, BBP, DBP, DIBP: each < 1000 ppm

SENECA continuously monitors REACH and RoHS regulatory developments to ensure that all products remain fully compliant with the applicable environmental regulations of the European Union.
