

ENVIRONMENTAL DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY REACH – RoHS – SCIP OBLIGATIONS

SENECA S.r.l., with registered office in Via Austria 26 – 35127 Padova (PD), Italy, declares that the electronic products designed, assembled and supplied to its customers comply with the European legislation in force on the protection of health, safety of operators and environmental protection, in compliance with the applicable provisions of the Regulations and Directives set out below.

REACH (Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 as amended)

Pursuant to the REACH Regulation, the products supplied by SENECA S.r.l. can be classified as "articles" as defined in art. 3, paragraph 3 of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 and, under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use, do not release substances hazardous to human health or the environment.

With reference to the February 2026 update of the ECHA Candidate List, which brings the total number of SVHCs (Substances of Very High Concern) to 253, including the following new substances:

- n-Hexane / n-Hexane (CAS No. 110-54-3 – EC No. 203-777-6 – Specific Target Organ Toxicity Following Repeated Exposure)
- 4,4'-(hexafluoroisopropylidene)diphenol and related salts (Toxic to Reproduction)

on the basis of the information currently available, the internal audits and the declarations received from the suppliers of components and materials, SENECA S.r.l. declares that none of the SVHC substances included in the ECHA Candidate List updated on the date indicated above is present in its products in a concentration higher than 0.1% w/w, as required by art. 33 of the REACH Regulation. Should future regulatory updates or changes in the composition of the materials require a new assessment, SENECA S.r.l. undertakes to provide timely communication to the customers concerned, in compliance with the information obligations provided for by the REACH Regulation.

SCIP (Substances of Concern In articles, as such or in complex objects – Products)

In compliance with art. 9, paragraph 1, letter (i) of Directive 2008/98/EC, as amended by Directive (EU) 2018/851 and transposed in Italy by Legislative Decree 116/2020, SENECA S.r.l. declares that, for its products, there is no obligation to notify the SCIP database managed by ECHA.

This exclusion is motivated by the absence of SVHC substances in a concentration higher than 0.1% w/w in the items supplied, based on technical assessments, documentary analysis and statements collected along the supply chain.

RoHS (Directive 2011/65/EU – Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 as amended)

SENECA S.r.l. products comply with Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS II) and its update introduced by Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 (RoHS III), concerning the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

The products comply with the concentration limits set out in Annex II of the Directive, taking into account any applicable exemptions provided for in Annexes III and IV.

Restricted substances and their maximum permitted limits:

- Piombo (Pb): < 1000 ppm
- Mercury (Hg): < 1000 ppm
- Cadmium (Cd): < 100 ppm
- Esavalent chromium (Cr VI): < 1000 ppm
- Biphenyl polybromurati (PBB): < 1000 ppm
- Ether diphenyl polybromurate (PBDE): < 1000 ppm
- DEHP, BBP, DBP, DIBP: each < 1000 ppm

SENECA S.r.l. constantly monitors the evolution of European legislation in the REACH, SCIP and RoHS areas in order to ensure the continuous environmental compliance of its products and the correct information along the supply chain.
