



DECLARATION ON THE USE OF CONFLICT MINERALS

SENECA is aware of the possible presence in its supply chain of "Minerals from conflict areas" as defined in Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, and California Senate Bill 861. Conflict-Area Materials" are those materials originating in the Democratic Republic of Congo or adjacent countries ("DRC countries") for the manufacture of products and include tantalum, tungsten, tin and gold.

SENECA is not directly subject to this Regulation. Nevertheless, the verifications carried out so far in the SENECA supply chain have shown that there are no deviations from these regulations. It is therefore assumed that SENECA products do not contain any of the above materials from the areas mentioned.

In addition, compliance with these regulations is an integral part of our supply terms and intrinsic to our controls carried out on suppliers.
